ADULT LEARNING PROGRAMME OF ENGLISH

Following the success of the Maths course held here at St White's, we are thrilled to now be offering you the chance to complete the Functional Skills English course starting on the 21st February 2018. The free course will be held every Wednesday between 9am-11am, with a funded crèche/nursery available if you have little ones not in school and will be for those people wanting to complete Entry Level, Level 1 or Level 2 English.

Improve Your English Skills:

You will be able to improve your written and spoken communication skills, be more effective at work and more confident to help your children with homework.

Entry Level English:

Improving your grammar, spelling and punctuation could make life easier, for example helping your children with homework or when you need to fill in forms and apply for services. It could help you if you need to write letters or take notes in meetings

Level 1 and 2 English:

The course is aimed at learners working towards a level 1 or level 2 qualification, you have the opportunity to achieve a qualification up to level 2 (equivalent to GCSE grade A-C or 9-5). The course is delivered in a way that makes the English language relevant to everyday life and helps you to progress in a chosen career or future employment, be able to take other training or educational opportunities and allow you to help support your own children with their homework.
