Lots of staff are really pleased to have this regular reassurance, and we hope that it will also help parents to feel that school is a safe place for children once we start to re-open, hopefully in March. We are waiting for confirmation from the government of when, and how we will start to re-open. We have been promised two weeks' notice to put our plans in place and we will let you know as soon as we can.
