

Technical vocabulary		
Write	To form letters and numbers that mean something.	
Digraph	Two letters that make one sound.	
Trigraph	Three letters that make one sound	
Segment	We break the word down into individual sounds or syllables to enable us to read it.	
Blend	We blend sounds together, e.g. 'd-o-g- dog'	
Sound	How you say a letter when you want to read it.	

We will be making sure we write our letters correctly using our 'lead ins' and letter formation rhymes.
