The two 'e' letters with accents are: 'É' accent aigu (acute accent) 'È' accent grave (grave accent) Accents on the letter 'e' changes the pronunciation. We will be able to pronounce: É, E, È, EAU, EAX QU, GNE, C, EN, AN

The date

Quelle est la date aujourd'hui ? = What is the date today? Aujourd'hui c'est... = Today it is...

A reminder that when saying the date in French there is no equivalent of our English st, nd, rd, th after the number apart from when saving the first date of the month. This is written as 'premier' or '1er'.

Grammar

Unlike in English, the days of the week and months of the year in French are not written with a capital letter. The only time they can be seen written with a capital letter is if they are at the start of a sentence.
