Well done to Miss Cinderey whose duck came first. We as a school raised over £350.00 for Children in Need so thank you to everyone who donated.



Attendance

It is a long time since we have given an attendance update! Our school attendance policy has an expectation that children attend every day unless they have a valid reason to be absent. This year, due to the coronavirus pandemic, the school is taking a cautious approach to children with coughs, colds and other illnesses, rather than our usual expectation of resilience. For this reason, we have decided it would be unfair to pupils who have erred on the side of caution and stayed away, so we will not be celebrating 100% attendance with badges and certificates this year – instead we will

send home certificates at the end each big term for children with "fabulous" attendance. Our whole school attendance figure since September is a fantastic 97.4%. Any pupils who are isolating due to suspected or known contact with covid cases are marked on the registers with an X code, and this means their absence for these days is not counted.
