To: Parents identified as Key Workers

The Government has asked schools, where possible, to make provision for the children of key workers to be able to attend school through the Easter Holiday period to enable parents to continue to meet their work shift requirements.

The school has arranged for staff from Progressive Sports to run a skeleton holiday club for the children of key workers only. This club is only open to pupils who are on roll at this school, and only when key worker parents are working.

The club will run on eight days during the Easter Holiday period from 8am until 5pm. This is from Monday 6<sup>th</sup> to Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> April and then from Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> to Friday 17<sup>th</sup> April.

There will be a charge for attending this club which is £20 per pupil, per day. We need to know as soon as possible whether there is a requirement for this club to go ahead, so if you need to book your child/children in for this service, please email the school on [admin@st-whites.gloucs.sch.uk](mailto:admin@st-whites.gloucs.sch.uk) with your requirements by the end of the day on Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> March.

Payment for the club will be required through parentpay in advance. A payment item will be created and invoices produced by the end of this week.
