Parent Information – Friday 2nd October 2020

Thank you so much to everyone who is following our school procedures to keep everyone safe – we really appreciate your help and support with this. We are especially grateful to those of you who are waiting patiently in the rain – at least we are all in this together which makes it more bearable.

Thank you very much to everyone for wearing face masks on the school site. This does make our staff feel much safer and we hope that it reassures parents as well.

Just a quick reminder to please make sure that you arrive punctually at the start of the school day. Unfortunately, because of the bubble system, we cannot allow children to enter the school if they are not here on time. The gates are closed as soon as the last parents have cleared the site from the morning drop off – at around 8.55am. Any children arriving after the gates are closed cannot be admitted to school for the day, and their absence will be recorded as unauthorised. We have noticed that some parents are parking on the road and letting children walk to the gate alone. It is particularly important that you make sure that the gate is still open and the children have been allowed onto the school site before driving away.

To further reduce the amount of people on the school site in the mornings, if there are any parents who are happy to allow their child/ren to walk from the gate to their classroom alone, we would encourage this. Please bring your child/ren to the gate at their correct arrival time. If you are not sure, please feel free to speak to the staff who are on duty at the gates.
