**RE: Parking Issues**

Due to recent incidents on the final day of last term and this week, the school has received several comments and concerns regarding parking on the Sneyd Wood Road side of the school.

The purpose of this letter is to remind parents and carers that the travel charter, adopted when the new school was built, requires us to actively encourage the use of the Buckshaft Road entrance to the school for dropping off and picking up at the start and end of the school day.

While we do encourage this, we also acknowledge that Sneyd Wood Road is a public highway. Any parent or carer using the estate roads or Buckshaft Road, should be mindful that when parking you are respectful to our neighbours and do not obstruct driveways or block any access routes.

Following recent incidents, if anyone has had their vehicle damaged, are subject to any public order offences or are blocked in themselves, then they should report this immediately to the Police who will investigate the incident.

The school has no right to intervene with these matters as the roads are, as mentioned, public highways. We will continue to encourage the use of Buckshaft Road (as required through our travel charter) but cannot accept any responsibility for any issues on any of the roads surrounding the school.
