RE: FINAL ARRANGEMENTS – TRIP TO BRISTOL HIPPODROME (ALADDIN)

As you are all aware the school will be closing at 12.00 noon on Friday, 15 December 2017 to take the pupils to see Aladdin at the Bristol Hippodrome. The whole school is incredibly excited! Detailed below are final arrangements for the day:-

1. SCHOOL UNIFORM

All children must be in full School Uniform for this trip.

2. SCHOOL LUNCH

School lunches are being served from 10.30 am on the morning of the trip to ensure that everyone receives their dinner and is ready to leave at 12.00 noon when the coaches arrive. There are two lunch options on the day of the trip. These are:

Fish Fingers and Chips Jacket Potato with Cheese

If you feel that your child will struggle to eat a hot lunch so early in the morning, the school is more than happy for you to supply a packed lunch for them instead.

3. SNACKS FOR TRIP

Please provide a sandwich and a small bottle of water for the children to take with them on the coach. They will eat this on their way back from the pantomime on the coach. Please do not send anything else.

4. RETURN TO SCHOOL

The aim is to be back at school for 6.00 pm. This, however, is highly dependent on traffic from Bristol to home. It is a Friday evening and the likelihood is that the volume of traffic will be high. With six coaches making the journey from Bristol, we cannot guarantee that they will all arrive at the exact same time. A message will be sent out to parents in the event that arrival is significantly delayed or earlier than 6pm. This will be sent via text or email so please do keep a look out for this.









5. COLLECTION OF YOUR CHILD(REN)

Please arrive at school at 6pm to collect your child/ren unless you have received a text that says the expected time of arrival has changed.

BOTH ENTRANCES WILL BE OPEN FOR PARENTS/CARERS TO COLLECT CHILDREN.
YOU MUST WAIT IN THE AUDITORIUM AREA. TO GAIN ACCESS BUZZ AS USUAL.
PLEASE BE PATIENT TO GAIN ENTRY AS THERE WILL ONLY BE THE SITE SUPERVISOR ON SITE TO LET EVERYONE IN!

PLEASE DO NOT WAIT OUTSIDE CLASSROOM DOORS AS PUPILS WILL ONLY BE RELEASED INSIDE THE SCHOOL BUILDING AND THERE IS NO LIGHTING AROUND THE OUTSIDE OF THE BUILDING.

When the pupils arrive back, they will be taken straight back to their classroom to collect their belongings, and will sit and wait until the parent/carer is instructed to go to the classroom to collect them.

Thank you in advance for your co-operation in all of the above. We are all thoroughly looking forward to the Pantomime, but take very seriously the safeguarding of each and every child in our care, and would therefore ask that you be patient with us when releasing the children, so that we ensure each child is delivered safely back to the rightful parent/carer.
