Dear Parents and Carers

Update on Coronavirus Situation

I am writing to tell you that this morning we have reviewed and updated our risk assessment for dealing with the coronavirus outbreak in the light of the Government announcement yesterday. Please be assured that the school is keeping up to date with Public Health and Government advice and taking all measures required.

From today, any child or staff member who exhibits symptoms of a temperature and/or a continuous cough will be sent home. Families are advised to use the 111 NHS website to confirm their symptoms and to follow the instruction to self isolate for seven days.

Within school, we are continuing to make sure that children and staff observe hygiene measures including frequent hand washing. From today we are asking all visitors who are coming into the building to wash their hands immediately and before leaving the building.

Children are being given information about the situation in their classes, in an age appropriate way. On Monday we will be holding a whole school assembly for the children and the details of this are being sent alongside this message.

For the time being all school trips and events are carrying on as arranged in line with national guidelines. We will continue to monitor the situation on a daily basis and will use parentmail to advise you of any changes.
