Optional Late Start and Bump Up Day – Monday 12th July

We are aware that lots of children will want to stay up late to watch the final of the Euros on Sunday night, and along with several other local schools we have decided to accommodate a later start on Monday 12th July. The school gates will be open at the usual times for children to arrive at their staggered start times. Children who are in school at the normal time will do exciting activities in class for the first lesson. The gates will then be closed by 9am. At 9.40am we will open the gates again for late arrivals, and children must be in promptly by 9.50am. We ask parents coming

at the later time to please continue to wear masks, observe social distancing, and clear the site as soon as possible.

Due to our increased concern because of local covid cases, we had already changed our plans for bump up day on Monday 12th July, so it will be done outside, one class at a time, to ensure there is no mixing of bubbles inside – this was due to start at 9am but we have managed to re-plan and the first class will now start at 10am.

At the end of the day the new class teachers will each hold a 15 minute Teams meeting for parents where they will introduce themselves and talk about their plans for next year. These sessions will run twice at 3.45pm and at 4pm to accommodate parents with children in different classes. The invitations for the Teams meetings will be sent out through Parentmail at 3.30pm on Monday afternoon.

Holidays in Term Time

The term dates for next year are published on the school website and attached along with this update. We are asking parents and carers to think very carefully before planning a holiday in term time. The children's education has been so badly disrupted over the last two years that it is more important than ever for them to be in school every day. Next year the school will apply for penalty notices wherever the conditions are met (five days of holiday within a ten week period) and the cost of the penalty is £60 per child, per parent – so for a family of four, the cost is £240 if paid within 21 days, after which it doubles.
