



Dear Parents and Carers,

Welcome Back – We hope you all had a fabulous Easter.

Our topic this term is 'Greece Lightning' and will be focused on ancient and modern day Greece. We will be learning all about this civilisation and their lifestyles and traditions. In addition to this, between now and the end of the year, we will be looking at systems of the body and electricity in science. Of course, French, music, PSHE, P.E will continue to run alongside our topic learning and will be linked to topic as closely as we can. Year 5 will be going swimming every Tuesday while the Year 6 revise for SATs and then rehearse their end of year production after that. PE for Heron will be Thursdays and Fridays. Mondays will see Peregrine doing Forest schools as well as PE on Fridays. Please ensure PE, Forest schools and swimming kits are in each week. Woodpecker have PE on Monday and then swimming on Tuesday.

This term we have the same homework books that we had throughout the year. On Fridays, the children will have their homework diaries checked and signed by the class teacher. It is expected that the children read at least 5 times a week and that this is recorded in their diaries. Their spellings for the following week and their dictation lists will also be given out. Every child will be responsible for changing their own books during their class library slot. Heron on Thursday, Peregrine on Wednesday and Woodpecker on Tuesday.

The children will continue to have mental maths books for maths homework this term. They will be expected to complete one page per week. If the children cannot do one of the calculations then they are to circle the number and I will go through it with them in their maths homework slot in the afternoon. After they have finished their page, they should mark their own work in a different colour so that when they return it to school, we know quickly what they need help with. Each group will be supported on a different day and this will be written on the front of their books. We will be having another learn alongside your child day on **Thursday 10th May**, This will be a maths session, we look forward to you joining us for this exciting morning.

This term's topic homework will be sent home this week. Like last term, there is one POWer Project for each short term. The children can choose which parts of the project they would like to complete. They have to complete 5 points in each project and each week we would like them to make a note in their diaries to tell us how it is progressing.
