EYFS	Where do we belong? We will share and explore special occasions in children's lives.	Why is Christmas special for Christians? Children will explore Christmas for Christians and understand the nativity.	Why is the word 'God' so important to Christians? We will discuss why God is so important to Christians and explore the wonders of the world.	Why is Easter special to Christians? Children will be able to retell the Easter story and recognise key Christian symbols.	What places are special and why? We will investigate local places of worship and ask questions as to why these are important.	What times / stories are special and why? Children will retell and create their own religious stories about God.
KS1 Year 1 and 2	Who do Christians say made the world? We will explore creation and read the story of Genesis.	What does it mean to belong to a faith community? Children will discover the importance of communities.	What makes some places sacred to believers? We will recognise that there are special places where people go to worship, such as a church or a synagogue.	Why does Easter matter to Christians? Children will become familiar with concepts such as resurrection and incarnation.	Who is Jewish and how do they live? Children will explore key religious symbols for Jews and their beliefs.	
LKS2 Year 3 and 4	How do festivals and worship show what matters to Muslims? Explore ways in which Muslims worship and celebrate special occasions.	How do festivals and family life show what matters to Jewish People? Explore key Jewish beliefs around sin and forgiveness.	Why do Christians call the day Jesus died 'Good Friday'? Celebrate salvation and how Jesus cam to rescue people.	For Christians, what was the impact of the Pentecost? Identify links between the story of Pentecost and Christian beliefs about the 'kingdom of God' on Earth.	How and why do people try to make the world a better place? Identify some differences in how people put their beliefs into action and make links between religious teachings and the world we live in.	What kind of world did Jesus want? Suggest ideas and then find out about what Jesus' actions towards outcasts meant for a Christian.
UKS2 Year 5 and 6	What does it mean if Christians believe God is holy and loving? Children will explore connections between biblical texts and Christian ideas of God, using theological terms.	What does it mean to be a Muslim in Britain today? Children will explore the Qur'an and make clear connections between Muslims beliefs.	How do Christians believe Jesus did to 'save' people? Children will understand connections between the Christian beliefs in Jesus' death as a sacrifice.	How do Christians decide how to live? What would Jesus do? Children will make connections between Gospel texts, Jesus' 'good news', and how Christians live in the Christian community.	Why do some people believe in God and some not? Children will explore and understand that everyone has different beliefs and celebrate everyone's opinion.	What matters most to Humanists and Christians? Children will identify and explain beliefs about why people are good and bad.
