- Psalm 103 is a Christian prayer that celebrates the Lord.
- Christians have stories which show how they believe God helped people.
- God is displayed as almighty, glory, righteous and gracious.
- Medieval Christians built cathedrals to show glory in God.
- Churches are often built in the shape of a cross with the altar facing east towards the rising sun.
- Humanists believe the world is a natural place and science gives us the best way to understand it (humanists don't believe in a god).
- Humanists believe we should be free to make the most of the one life we have, seeking happiness and supporting others to do the same.
- Humanists believe we should use empathy and consider the impact of our actions on other people and animals.

<b>Biblical</b>	relating to the bible
<b>theological</b>	the study of the nature of God and religious beliefs.
<b>worship</b>	expression of reverence
<b>reverence</b>	showing of deep respect
<b>Psalm</b>	a sacred song from the Bible.
<b>Prophet</b>	an inspiring teacher or follower of God
<b>contemporary</b>	something that occurs in the present
<b>almighty</b>	having a power
<b>righteous</b>	being morally correct
<b>attributes</b>	a quality or feature which is part of something or someone.
<b>Amen</b>	usually heard at the end of a prayer and means 'so be it'.

### Christian Prayers and stories

**Psalm 103** – a prayer of King David.  
**Isaiah** – a story where a prophet has a religious experience.  
**John 4** – a story about a follower of Jesus writing a letter about what God is like.  
**The Lord's Prayer** – a prayer about God and what he is like.  
**Hail Mary** – a prayer about Mary.

### Key figures

- **John** - was the son of Zebedee, a Galilean fisherman, and Salome. **John** and his brother St. James were among the first disciples called by Jesus.
